In Kettering we currently have about 70 listening volunteers who give up their time freely and willingly to help those in distress.In addition to daytime and evening duties, each Samaritan volunteer is expected to be on duty during the night from 11 p.m. - 2 a.m or 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Our night duties can be and often are very busy as it is during the night when callers are at their lowest and their fears, worries and problems seem to be overpowering.

It is often easier for a caller to talk to a completely anonymous volunteer and reveal their most personal and distressing thoughts, rather than offload to a family member or friend for fear of worrying or upsetting that person.

We can be contacted by 'phone, Email, text or in person at our office in Montagu Street, Kettering and are at the end of the 'phone to listen and support our callers but never to give advice.

Whatever you're going through, we'll go through it with you.
