

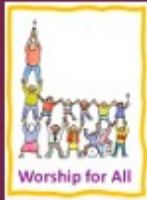



A good man intent on making the world a better place, Father James (Brendan Gleeson) is continually shocked and saddened by the spiteful and confrontational inhabitants of his small country town.

One day his life is threatened during confession. He shrugs off the altercation and continues to perform his pastoral duties, trying as best he can to help his parishioners.


Soon, however, the sinister undercurrents he has tried to ignore start to make their presence felt more keenly and as the forces of darkness close in around him he begins to wonder if he will have the courage to face his own personal calvary.

Oscar winner Penélope Cruz stars as Janis, an accomplished photographer who is looking into the disappearance of family members during the Franco era and hooks up with an archaeologist (Israel Elejalde) when she gets pregnant. In hospital she meets Ana (Milena Smit). Both are single and became pregnant by accident. Janis, middle-aged, has no regrets and is exultant. Ana, an adolescent, is scared and repentant. The few words they exchange in these hours will create a very close link between them which, by chance, will develop and complicate their lives in a decisive way as Janis continues her investigation into the past.

This film has Almodóvar's usual penchants for highlighting the warmth of female relationships and for a narrative with several strands which sorts itself out well enough by the film's end.
